

Boarding Policies And Recommendations

Health Care and Safety:

- All pets must be in good general health to board. Dogs must be a minimum of 4 months old and a maximum of 12 years old. Pets over the age of 12 will be accepted with a health certificate from a veterinarian. Any existing health problem (medical, physical or behavioral) requires advance review of the pet before we can accept your reservation. Special medical requirements are subject to additional charges. If your pet takes any medications, vitamins, or supplements that will need to be administered during their stay, please complete and present the medication form. Call ahead to make sure we accept the medication being administered. Paws2tail does not administer injections. All medication that accompanies the pet must be in its original container. There is an additional charge for this service.
- All dogs must be spayed or neutered as a condition to staying with us.
- We cannot accept any pregnant pets or females in heat. All pets are observed regularly throughout the day. If urgent care is required, the pet will be transported to a veterinarian. Dogs must be brought in on a leash and wear a collar with identification. As a safety precaution, dogs will also be tagged with Paws2tail identification keys while they are staying with us. Paws2tail will provide and feed premium kibble routinely twice a day for an additional \$5.00 per day per dog. We highly recommend bringing your own food to ensure consistency of a healthy diet. We do not accept raw food diets.

Vaccination Requirements:

- For health and safety reasons, all pets must be current on their vaccinations prior to check-in. Vaccines must have been administered by a licensed veterinarian. Dogs are required to have had a Rabies vaccination (1 or 3 year vaccines are acceptable), a DHLPP vaccination (1 or 2 year vaccines are acceptable), and a Bordetella vaccine. Bordetella vaccinations must have been administered within the last 6 months and at least one week before your pet's stay.

Length of Stay:

- Paws2tail has a limit on how many dogs it may have. For this reason, we recommend that you make reservations at least one month in advance. One and a half months (or 6 weeks) is the maximum time that Paws2tail will board your pet. Please notify us of any change or cancellation of your reservation. If you pick up your pet before 12:00 noon, you will not be charged for that day. Pick ups after 12:00 noon will be charged an additional day of boarding. We will not release your pet to anyone but you without prior written notification.
